# Background

- At the last Members meeting, JICA expressed interest in leading the platform with some focus on One Stop Border Posts.
- Other members, while broadly supporting the initiative, suggested to include other issues such as ports.
- Based on the above, the concept note is drafted by ICA secretariat and JICA with advice from other members for discussion among all the ICA Members.

- B) Coordinating development partners in order to make their interventions even more effective
- C) Deepening knowledge sharing among African partners and development partners

- B) Practical Platform for Coordination and Knowledge Sharing for *Better Implementation*
- C) Promoting African development through close dialogue with RECs
- D) Fully utilizing existing structures without creating duplication

# Membership & Structure

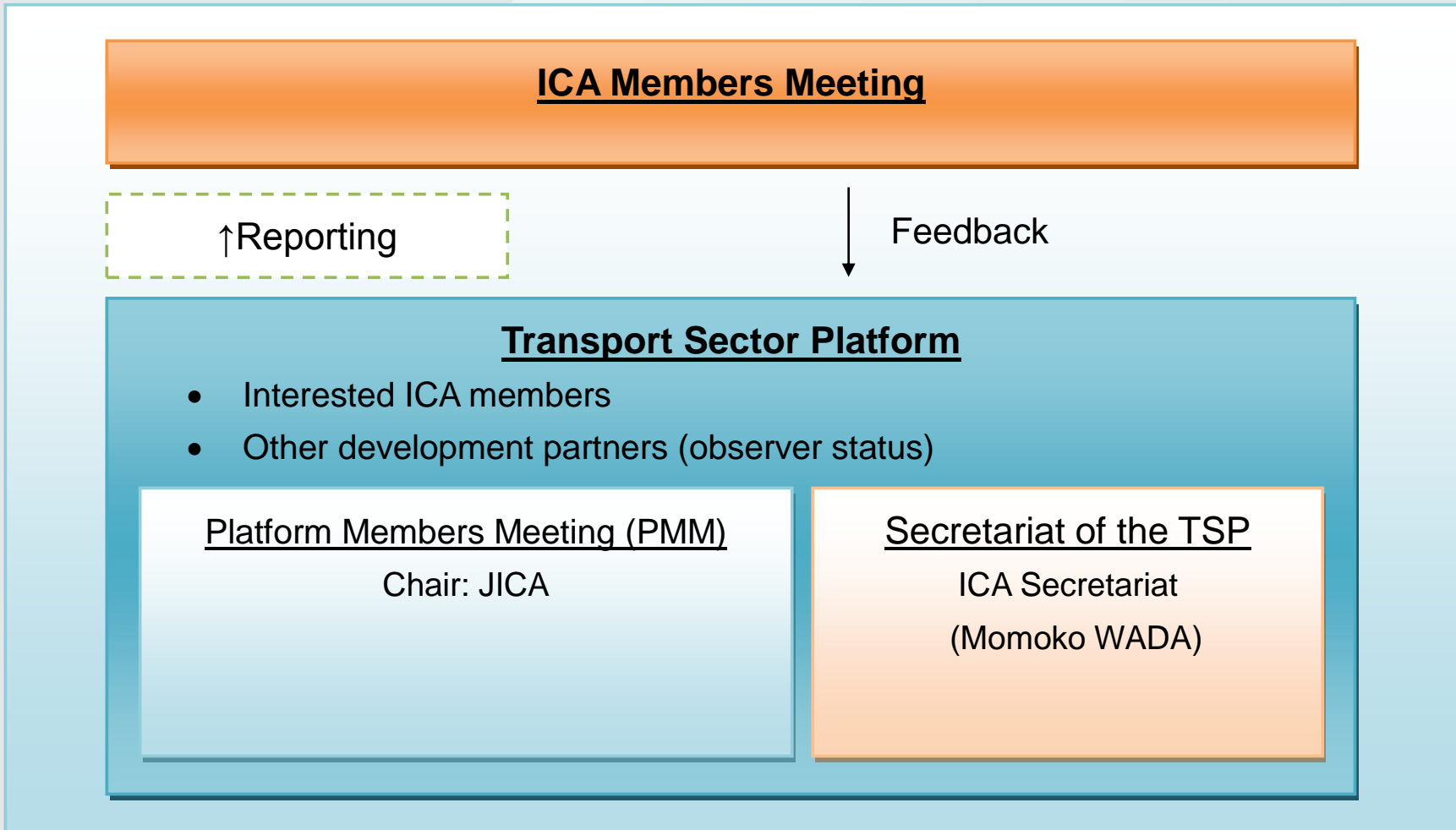
## ■ Membership & Partnership

- Non-ICA development partners including private sector stakeholders (observer status)
- RECs as crucial partners

## ■ Structure

- Platform Members Meeting (PMM) to be held biannually before ICA members meeting
- Decisions made at PMM is to be reported to ICA Members Meeting
- JICA chairs TSP/PMM
- ICA Secretariat (Ms. Momoko WADA) functions as the secretariat of TSP/PMM

# Activities for 2011

## ■ Promoting the OSBPs

- Development of OSBPs Sourcebook with EAC
- OSBPs Workshop inviting other RECs and DPs

## ■ Facilitation of Ports and Airports PPPs

- TA for facilitating private participation
- Support for improving aviation safety

## ■ Establishing knowledge archive

- Collecting data and reports on regional transport infrastructure development
- Share them with members and public through ICA website

# Financial Resources

- JICA: US\$ 100,000-150,000/year mainly for activities on OSBPs
- EIB: EUR 100,000/year (maximum) over 3 years mainly for Ports and Airports

- Concept Note to be finalized by mid December 2010
- Each activity starts respectively from Jan, 2011
