Principles

- Alignment with African Priorities
- □ Close Cooperation with AMCOW, AUC, RECs, RBOs
- Coordination should be led by the African side to demonstrate ownership
- Principle of selectivity or prioritization of projects
- Coordination amongst initiatives who takes the lead?
- ICA to work as catalyst for resource mobilization and investment promotion based on its convening power



Potential areas/role of future support

- □ Support implementation of PIDA PAP on the transboundary water component & investment programs of RECs/RBOs
 - Resource mobilization through a program on investment promotion and match-making conferences (ex HoAI)
 - Desegregation of 9 PIDA projects into hard and soft investment components
- ☐ Resource mobilization from different sources
 - Private Sector : bringing the private sector on board (Dakar)
 - Access to Green Climate Funds
 - Investment and business development Intelligence (Information)
 - Advocacy for resource mobilization
 - Engagement with the Regional Development Banks (contact BOAD)



Potential areas/role of future support

- ☐ Information Sharing amongst the different RECs
 - Support for development of comprehensive strategic frame work for transboundary water products.
 - Finding ways to support implementation of cross border investments
 - Facilitate the exchange among RECs/RBOs (TWINNING) –showcasing experience of NELSAP
- ☐ Support for Knowledge Products
 - AUC Monitoring and Evaluation Programmes for the development of indicators of water standards
 - Exchange of best practices and experiences in Transboundary Water Resource Management (workshops / publications)
 - Continue to close the Data Gap (through AIKP)



Potential areas/role of future support

- Climate Financing
 - Development of strategies to tap into Climate Financing –set of recommendations (absorption capacity)
 - ☐ Green Climate Funds (COP 17)
 - ☐ Climate Investment Funds (CIFs)
 - Carbon Funds
