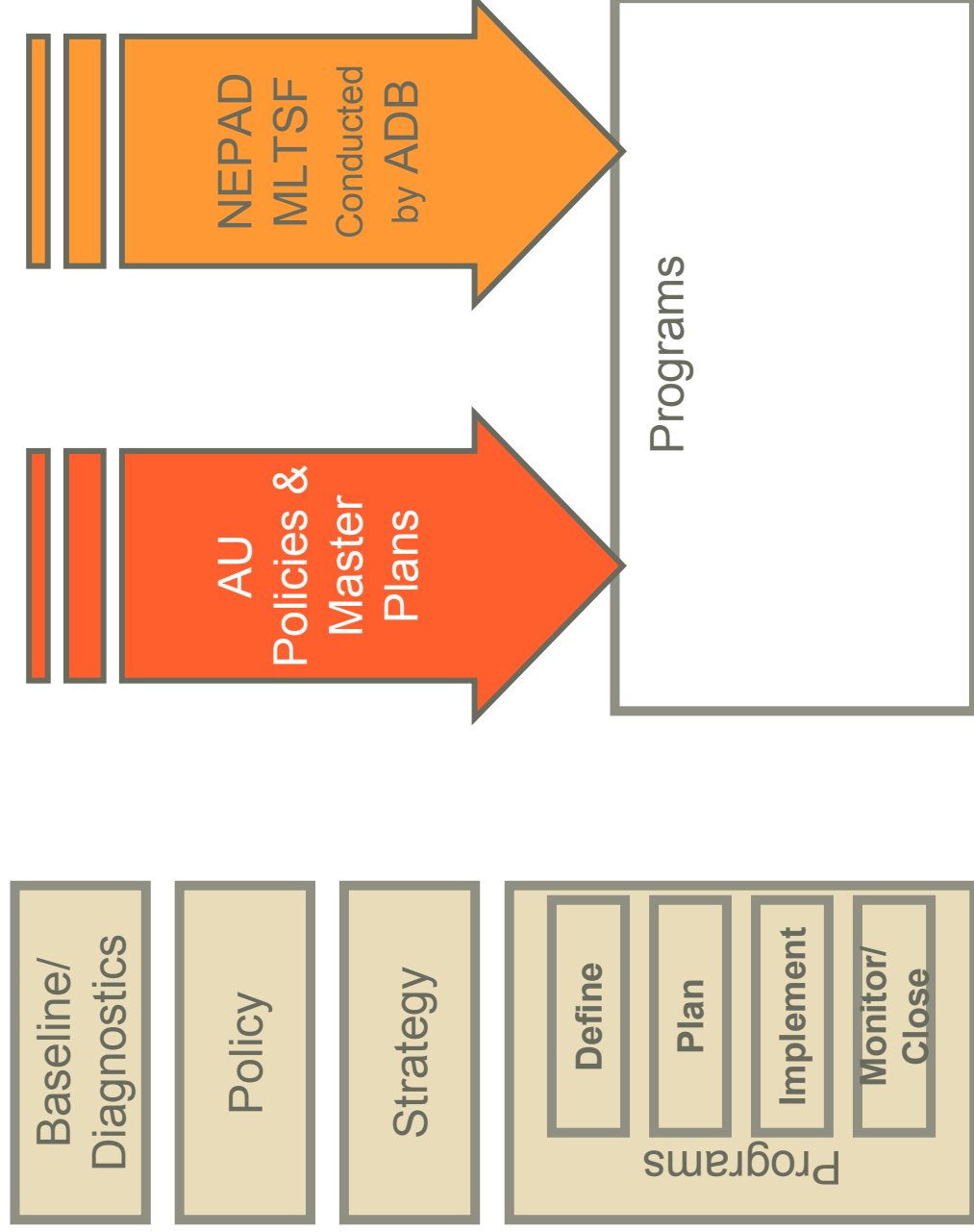

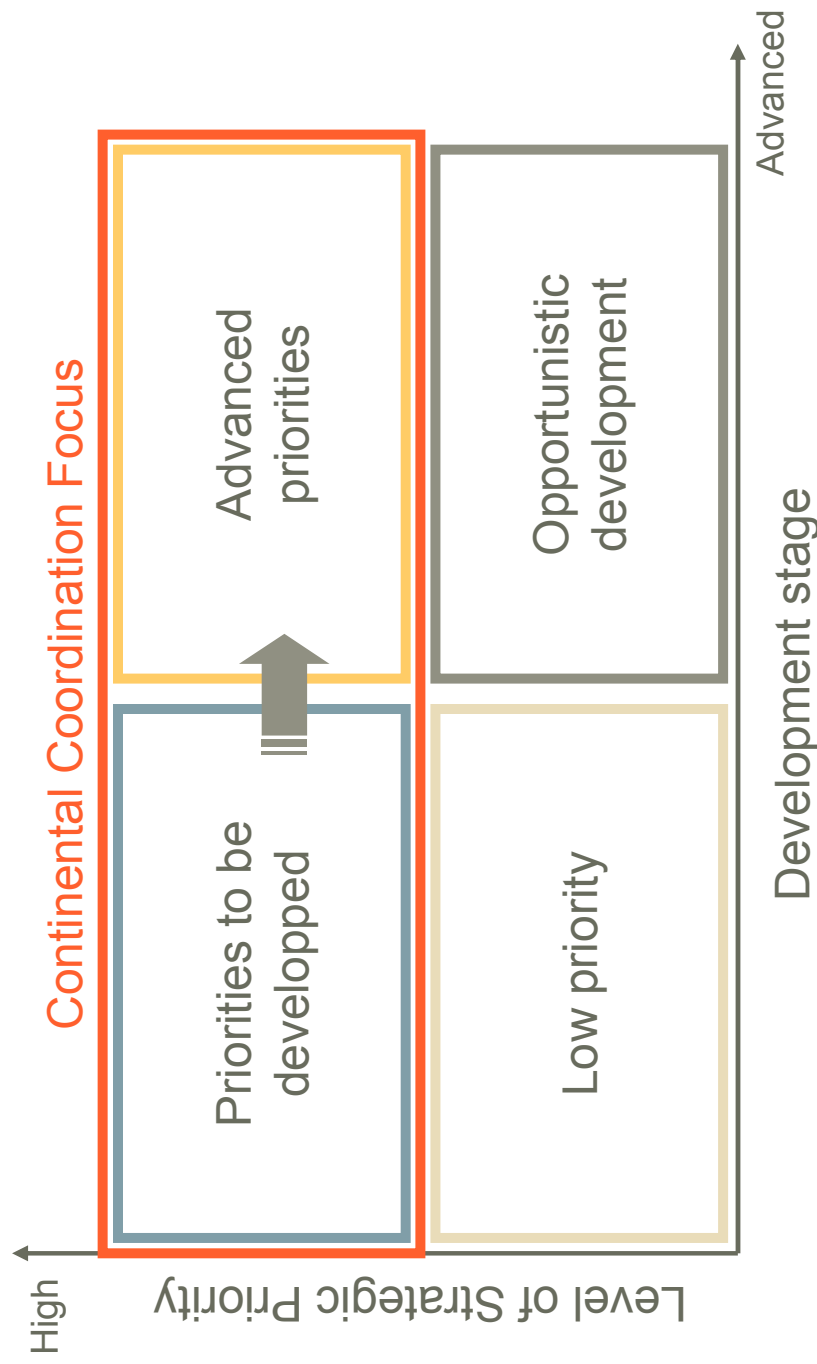

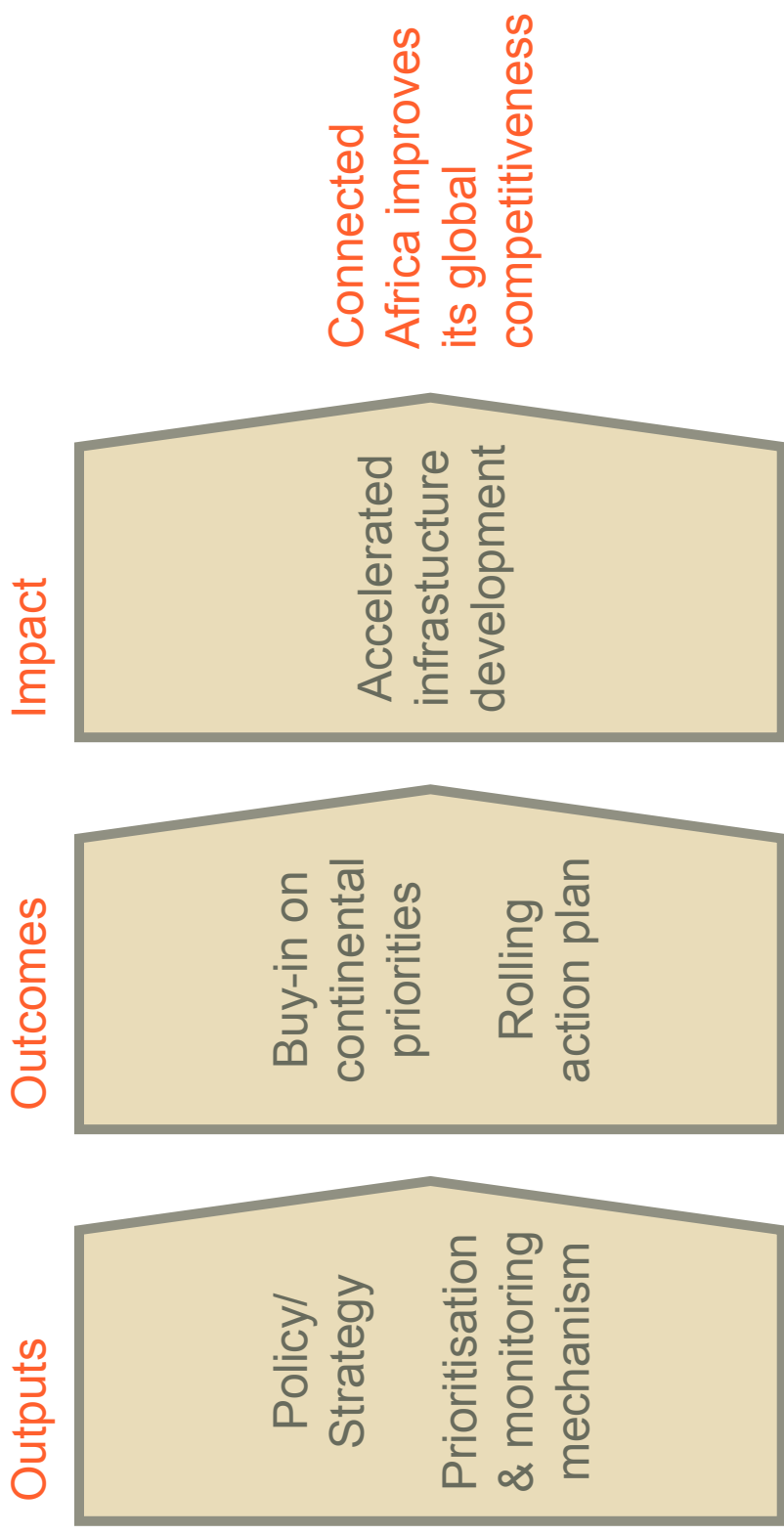
# African institutions now aim at consolidating continental programs...



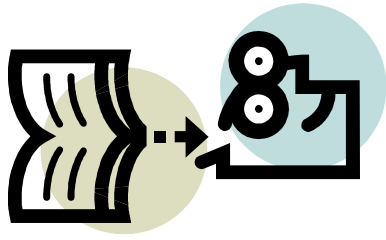
# With a consensus on the issue at stake: building a common prioritisation framework



# The study is the first step of a chain of objectives

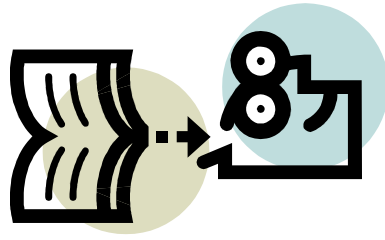


## Lessons need to be drawn from AUC Sectoral & Continental Master Plans Initiatives



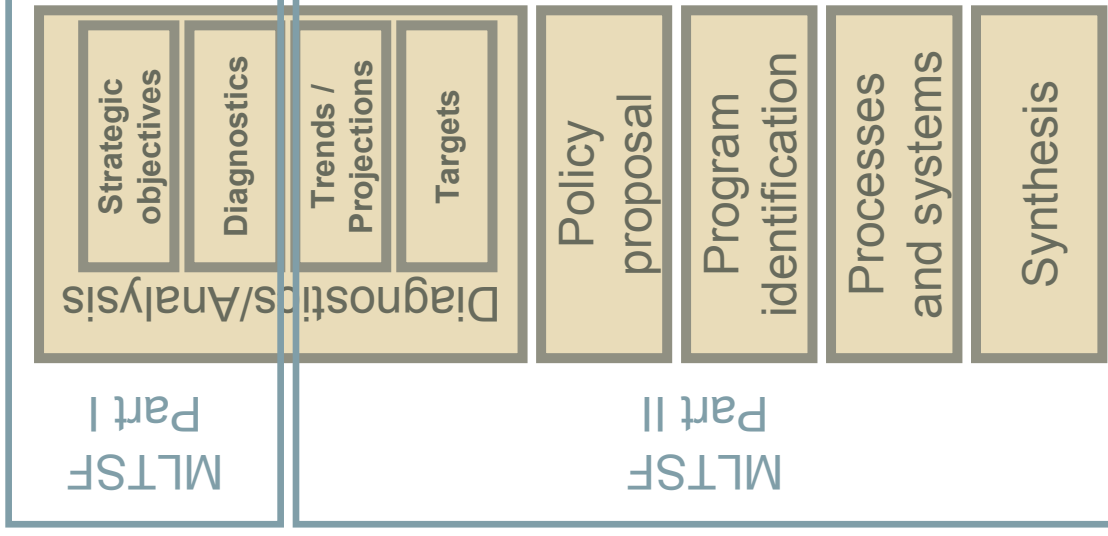
- RECs involvement must be stronger
- The Attendance of RECs to different workshops might be better planned (less participants per workshop)
- Utilisation of Consultants expertise need to be strengthened (more experts...)

# Lessons need to be drawn from MLTSF implementation



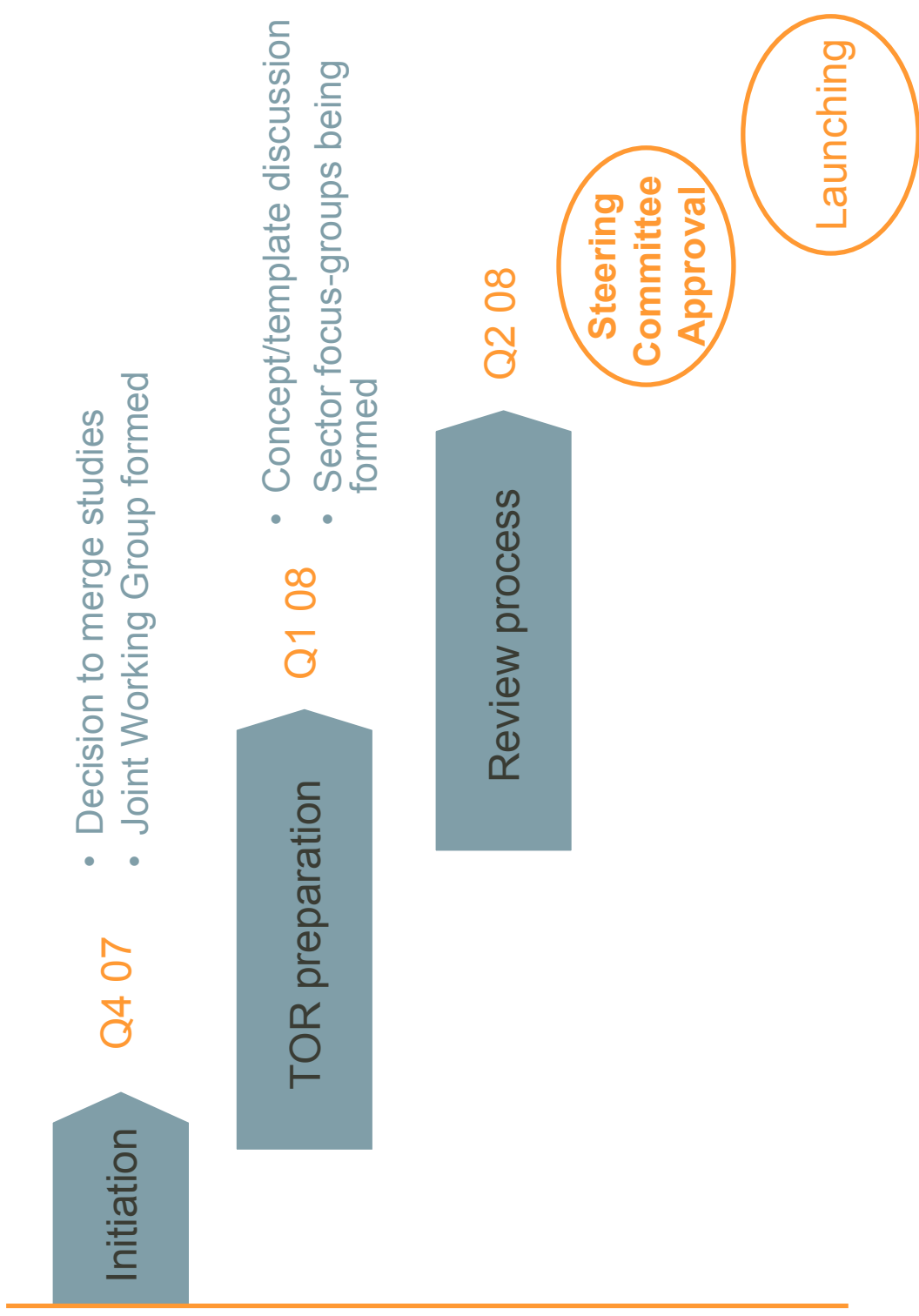
- Data collection process needs improvement
- Coordination teams need to be strengthened for more technical involvement from ADB and stronger consultant leadership
- Consultation workshops might need to be more focused (less participants per workshop?)
- Consultants expertise need to be reoriented (more economists, big picture thinkers?)
- We need more flexibility built in, so that the approach can be adapted as we go if needed

# The study is re-structured along key steps



- Taking stock of existing knowledge to define key binding constraints to be addressed
- Analysis of global trends impacting infrastructure development (commodity prices, climate change, etc)
- Demand projections and scenarii
- Objectives and Targets
- Analysis of possible policies and strategies based on a thorough understanding of existing regional strategies
- Identification/confirmation of priority programs for each region
- Proposal for sustainable prioritization and monitoring mechanisms
- Synthesis of continental priorities
