

Financing Infrastructures for Trans-boundary Water Resource Management



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Case 1: Second Mekong International Bridge Construction Project

JBIC's first ODA Loans for a cross border infrastructure project. L/A was signed on 2001.12.27.

Loan amounts are 4,011 million yen (Laos) and 4,079 million yen (Thailand).

Case 2: Cross-border highway projects under the Accelerated Co-Financing Facility for Africa with AfDB

Ex) Road Improvement and Transport Facilitation Program
on the Southbound Bamako (Mali)-Dakar (Senegal)
Corridor.

L/A was signed on 2006.03.31.

Ex) Arusha (Tanzania)-Namanga-Athi River (Kenya) Road
Development Project.

L/A was signed on 2007.03.09.

Case 3: Brantas River Integrated Development in Indonesia

Development of the Brantas River Basin has been achieved based on the principal of “One River, One Plan, One Management” .

In 1961, the Brantas River Basin Development Project was launched. Since that time, JBIC has played an ongoing key role in the development and management of the Brantas River Basin through financial support and technical assistance.

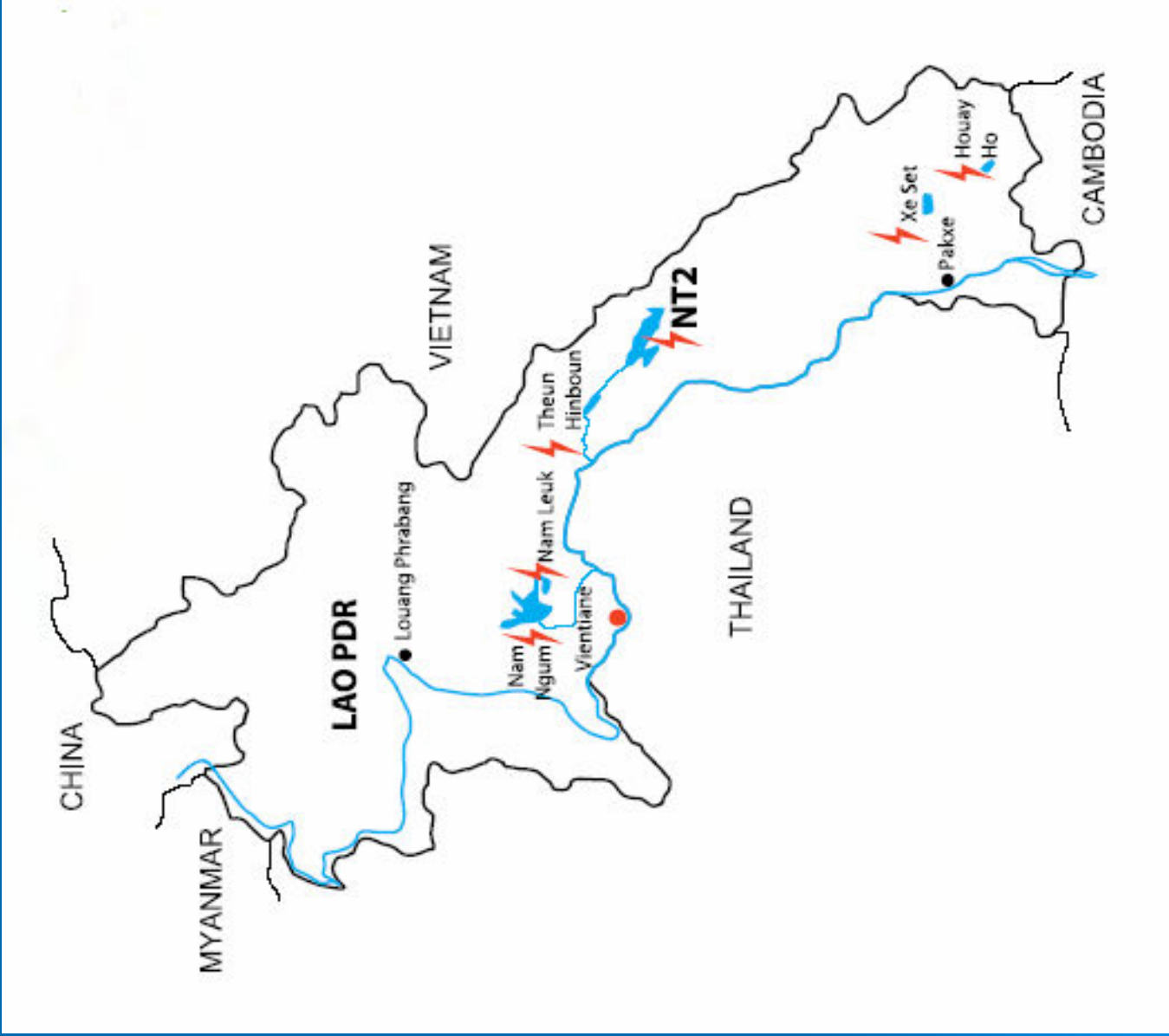
JBIC’s study recommended the establishment of a river basin management agency (Jasa Tirta-I Public Corporation) and strengthening of IWRM in the basin.

As a result, autonomous integrated water resources management in the river basin was achieved through infrastructure development accompanied by institutional and capacity raising of human resources.

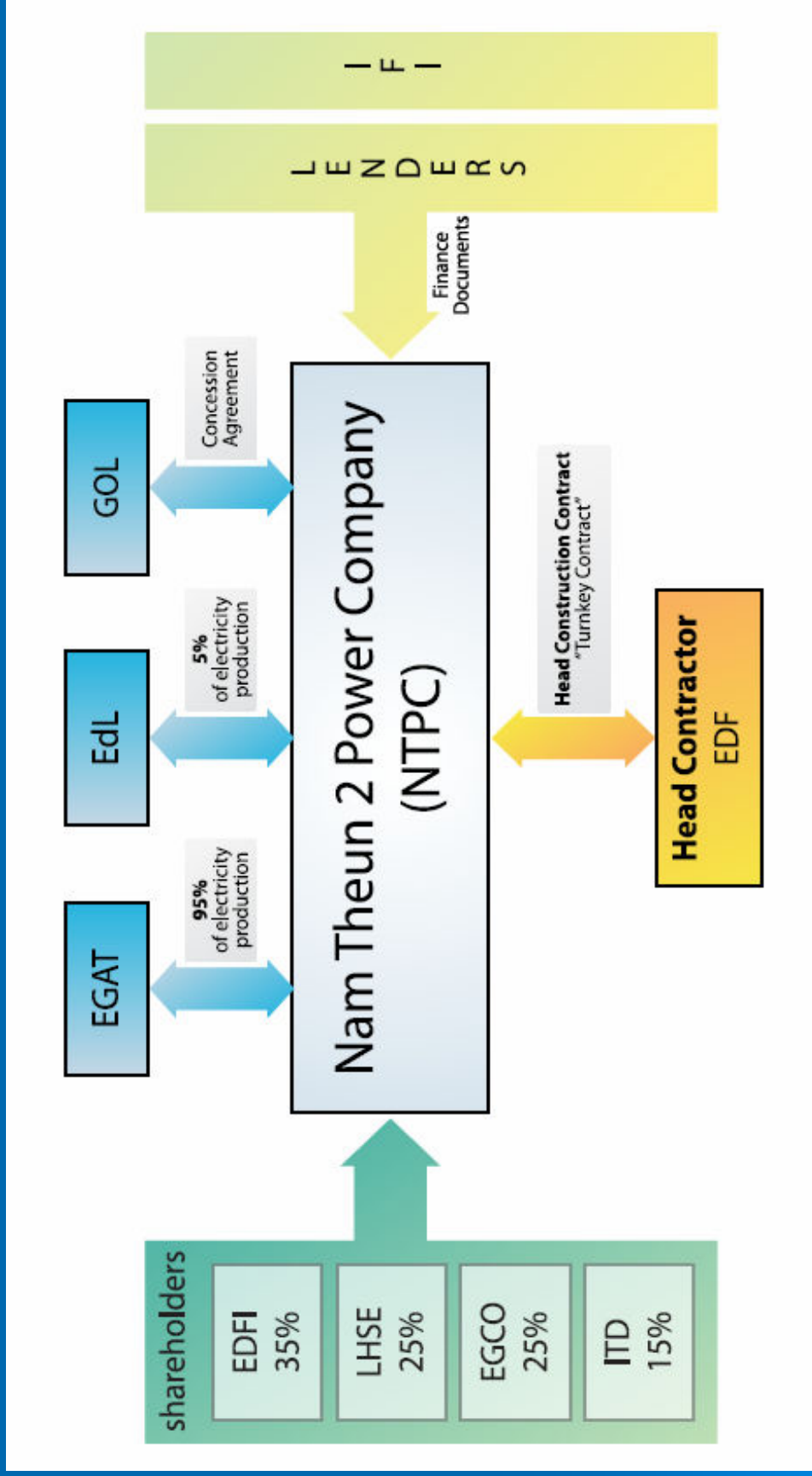
